Local Offer

SNAP PCF have continued to work with Central Bedfordshire Council (CBC) to develop the Local Offer. We held two Parent Panels to review the Education and Care part of the Local Offer. From the findings of our 'Satisfaction of SEND Services Survey', 55% of parents told us they had not heard of the Local Offer. CBC have committed to advertising the Local Offer in the New Year to ensure as many families as possible know what the Local Offer is. In the mean time please look at The Local Offer. As parents we need the information to be up-to-date and helpful, enabling us to navigate ourselves through the SEND system.

Annual Review Training

Parents asked us to arrange training on the Annual Review Process for their child's Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP). We delivered two evening training sessions and invited Louise Bartos, Head of SEND and Hero Slinn, SEND Manager to deliver this training which was similar to what had been delivered to schools. The feedback from parents was really positive and we plan to run more sessions in the future including; training on the Annual Review Process for when your young person is aged 14+ and Preparing for Adulthood.

Who is SNAP PCF?

SNAP PCF role is to be a critical friend to the Local Authority (LA) and the Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) regarding services they provide to the SEND community ages 0-25 years.

Our focus is to enable parents to participate and have a voice. We do this by holding coffee mornings and running Parent Panels (this is where you review a service the local authority or health provides, we give you a £15.00 M&S voucher for attending). We also inform and empower parents by holding an annual conference where we invite heads of service from the local authority to attend and to meet with you for a mini surgery.

We also have a Satisfaction of SEND Services Survey running which we will use to inform our priorities and give to OFSTED and the CQC when they carry out their SEND Area Inspection in Central Bedfordshire - details of the survey can be found here:
