It is run by parents for parents and a warm welcome awaits. There is no need to book, it is free to attend and children are welcome (you are responsible for your child, no creche is provided).

Parent Panels

So far we have focused on the Early Years section of the Local Offer and the Children with Disabilities Team Local Offer http://www.centralbedfordshire.gov.uk/children/sen-disability/landing.aspx The feedback from Central Bedfordshire Council Officers who attended the meetings were positive as it helped to; understand what parents were looking for, their frustrations when they couldn't find this and what needed to be prioritised first. We also ran a Parent Panel helping to develop information leaflets to be displayed at The Edwin Lobo Centre with Cambridge Community Health Trust. The feedback was, 'It was really interesting to hear all the thoughts and ideas of parents and they will make sure they incorporate as many as possible'.
